Ministry to JEWISH PATIENTS & FAMILIES

INTRODUCTION

The Spiritual Care staff at Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center is an interfaith team who visits patients and their families in the inpatient units and in the outpatient clinics. The staff members bring with them their faith tradition and training that enables them to minister to members of their own faith communities. At Roswell Park a community Rabbi and Chaplain are available to help with rituals and traditions of the Jewish faith on an on call basis.

MAY WE BE OF SERVICE? VISITATION

The Chaplains and Spiritual Care Visitors are available for prayer and general visitation. If there are any circumstances particular to your own synagogue life, or if you have questions we may help you with, members of the team are available to talk with you.

RELIGIOUS ARTICLES

Bibles, Prayer Books, Talit, Tefillin, Electric Sabbath candles and Yarmulkas/Kipaot are available through the Spiritual Care Office.

KOSHER FOOD

Kosher food is available. You can contact the Spiritual Care office or Dietitian for the kosher meals available.

Members of the Spiritual Care staff visit inpatient units and outpatient clinics Monday through Friday from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. A Chaplain and Spiritual Care Visitors are available on the weekends and on holidays. If you would like a visit, please call extension 8051 or 8852, or ask your physician, nurse or other member of your Roswell Park care team to make the request for you.
