Over 600 guests attend the Walk of Life dedication ceremonies held every year in Kaminski Park.



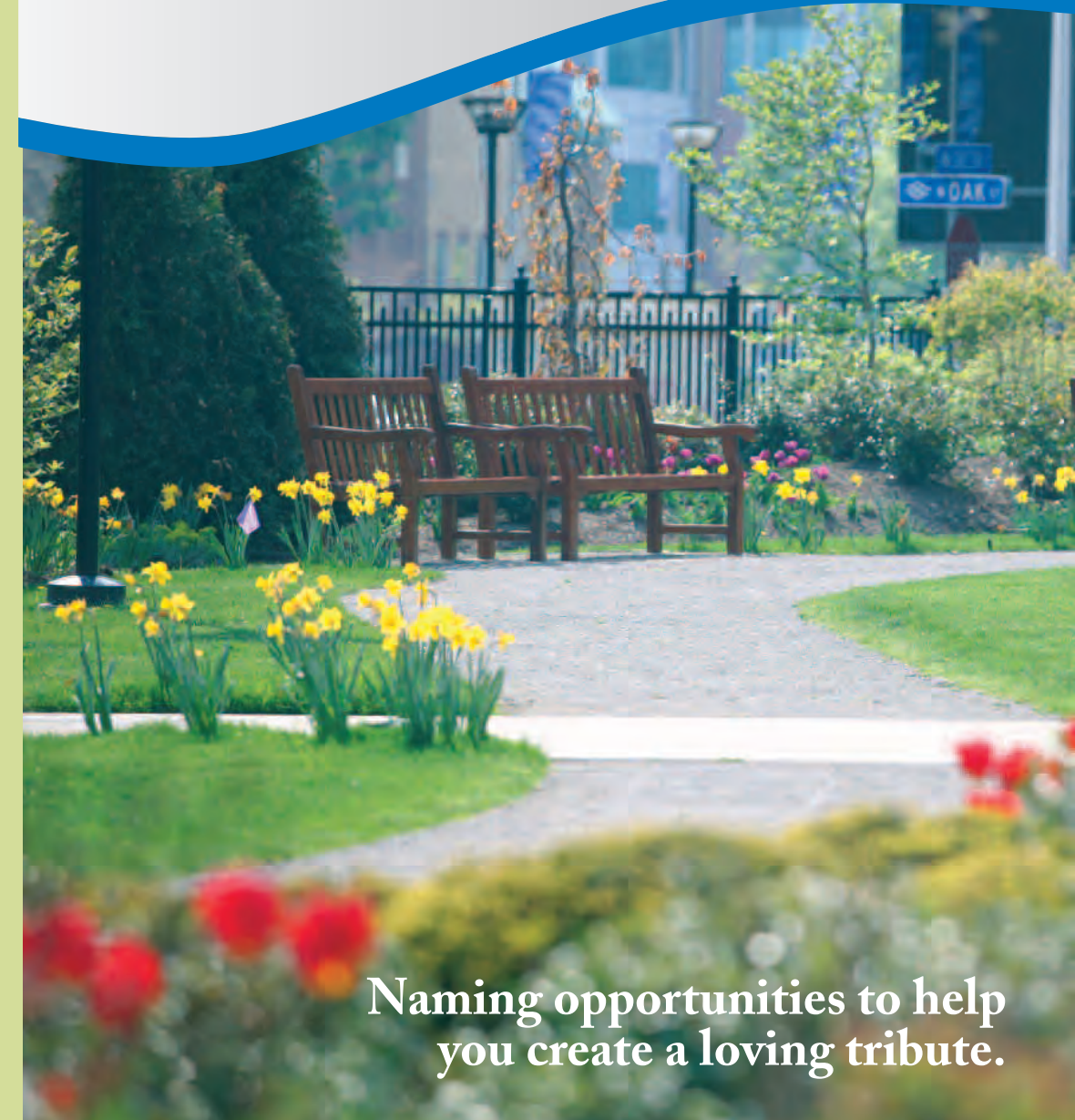

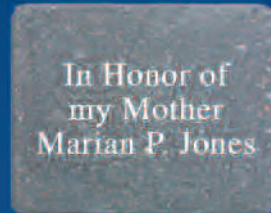

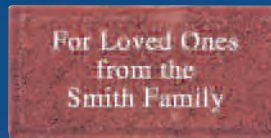
