

Preparing For Home

A Discharge and Telephone Guide for Patients on 6 West

At the Hospital

When you are ready to be discharged from the hospital, we want to assure you that you are healthy enough to go home and make sure that you are fully prepared. You may be sent home with challenging home care instructions and we want you and your caregivers to feel confident in your ability to provide care at home.

Here are some tips on how to have a smooth transition:

- Write down any questions you have for your doctor or nurse before you leave.
- Make sure you have received your written discharge instructions from your doctor and that you and your caregivers have had time to discuss them with your nurse.
- If you think you will need assistance when you get home, please ask your nurse to contact your Case Manager, who can help you arrange home care services.
