The American College of Radiology recommends that your physician makes sure your kidneys are working normally before resuming your medication.

You received of IV (intravenous) contrast today at Roswell Park for either a CT scan or an angiogram. Your kidneys will clear the contrast from your body, usually within 24 hours. In order to make sure your kidneys continue to work properly, it is important to drink extra fluids.

## **Oral Hydration**

- We recommend drinking at least 12 ounces (1.5 cups) of fluid every 2 hours for the next 24 hours.
- Water is the best fluid to drink, but any caffeine-free beverage(s) is okay.
- Milk or any other dairy beverage is not recommended. (Dairy beverages are cleared from your body by your GI tract, not your kidneys.)
