



Medical ID Jewelry



Medical ID jewelry provides a quick, easy way to let others, including first responders, know about your medical conditions, allergies, medications, or treatment wishes. It can speak for you if there is an emergency, and you are not able to communicate. First responders and medical personnel are trained to first look for medical IDs in an emergency.

If you have a **DNR order**, you can put a DNR engraving on your medical ID jewelry. The bracelet does not guarantee that medical personnel will abide by the order, so always have your signed order available to make sure your wishes will be followed.

Many health care insurance providers and Flexible Spending Accounts will reimburse you for the cost of your medical ID jewelry. Contact your health insurance provider for details.
