WHAT IS FOBT?

FOBT = FECAL OCCULT BLOOD TEST

This test looks for "hidden" blood in the stool, which may be a warning sign of polyps or colorectal cancer.

WHEN SHOULD I COMPLETE AN FOBT?

All average risk men and women age 50-75, who choose to be screened with high sensitivity FOBT, should complete this test every year.



There are many different types of FOBT. Most have the following steps:

- PICK-UP an FOBT kit from your IHS or Tribal Health Facility
- 2. ASK if there are any food or medication restrictions
- SET-UP toilet to collect stool above water
- **4.** COLLECT a small sample of stool according to kit instructions
- **5. REPEAT** up to three times, depending on which kit you use
- RETURN completed kit to lab, clinic or hospital

FOBT RESULTS

IF YOUR FOBT IS POSITIVE:

A positive FOBT does not always mean that you have cancer.

IF YOUR FOBT IS NEGATIVE:

- Polyps and cancers do not bleed all of the time
- Therefore all average risk men and women age 50-75 should still complete a FOBT every year

NOTE: If your test is positive it is important to have a colonoscopy as a follow-up exam!
