INPATIENTS

Inpatients may designate **TWO VISITORS TOTAL.**



Only **ONE VISITOR** allowed **PER DAY** during visiting hours.

*VISITING HOURS

Noon - 6 p.m. every day, including weekends and holidays.



***ALL VISITORS MUST ARRIVE BEFORE 5 P.M.**

Inpatient visitors must first check in at registration (on the right) to get their visitor pass before they get screened.

VISITORS COMING TO SEE INPATIENTS AT ROSWELL PARK MUST SHOW PROOF OF VACCINATION FOR COVID-19 OR A RECENT NEGATIVE PCR COVID-19 TEST

ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PROOF

← **Negative PCR (polymerase chain reaction) test MUST be taken within the past 72 hours.**

Exceptions will be granted only in rare cases where unusual circumstances are present.

These protocols are necessary to protect Roswell Park's patients, who have weakened immune systems and are at risk for severe impacts if exposed to the virus that causes COVID-19.

OUTPATIENTS



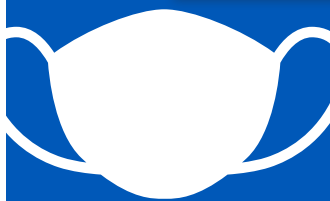
Roswell Park patients coming for outpatient appointments may have **ONE (1) VISITOR ONLY.**



Outpatients and their support person/visitor must go through entry screening **TOGETHER.**

Outpatients must enter through the center lane (Lane 2) along with their support person to be screened.

EVERYONE ON CAMPUS



UNIVERSAL MASKING REQUIRED

Masks are required for **patients, visitors, employees** and volunteers while indoors in any Roswell Park building, **regardless of vaccination status.**

You may remove masks only in order to eat or drink, and maintain distancing of 6 feet from others while doing so.
