- \* No refund will be given for Registration fee


#### **Dates**



## Spiritual Care Visitors TRAINING PROGRAM

Spiritual care of the sick and injured, the dying and the bereaved, is a primary ministry for all religious denominations. Meeting the physical, social, emotional and spiritual needs of patients and our congregations is an immense challenge and requires the intervention and assistance of mature, well-balanced, compassionate people who have been specially trained for this work.

At Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center, our Spiritual Care Visitors 15-Week Training Program is designed to provide men and women of various faiths, ordained and non-ordained, with professional training in key theoretical, theological and practical approaches to Spiritual care.

Roswell Park's Spiritual Care Director and faculty pursue a holistic approach to medicine, mindful of the fact that each human being is worthy of and entitled to total patient care. Roswell Park recognizes the value of faith and its place in the healing process.

The Spiritual Care Visitors 15-Week Training Program at Roswell Park enables members of our Spiritual Care Team to provide participants with pertinent knowledge and tools to enable them to minister in a hospital setting, nursing home, and/or in the faith community.



### Goals and Objectives

The program is designed to provide participants with:

- The necessary tools to minister in a specialized, Spiritual care environment.
- A keener awareness of the need for shared ministry to the sick.
- A sensitivity to other faith traditions and experiences of God as well as to cultural, gender and age differences.
- An understanding of the medical and ethical issues that may impact the healing process.
- A forum to share insights, feelings, situations and experiences in ministry.
- Individual supervision.
- An opportunity for personal growth through group interaction, personal interviews with a supervisor, written evaluations, and lectures.

### **Program Basics**

The Spiritual Care Visitors training is a two-part 15 week in person program consisting of the following:

Monday afternoon (1 to 4 pm) program consisting of active clinical spiritual care experience at Roswell Park under the supervision of a qualified chaplain.

These afternoon three-hour session include actual clinical experience, allowing face to face interaction with patients, rotating written assignments including verbatims; personal and ministry goals; reflections; evaluations; group interaction; and supervisory sessions.

#### AND

Monday Evening (5 to 7 pm) lecture series covering 30 hours of actual classroom work.

## Registration

Registration for the Monday Spiritual Care
Visitors Clinical Training Program will be limited
to six students. A written application, a personal
interview and a letter of recommendation from
your pastor or spiritual leader are required. After
receiving your application, you will be interviewed
by the Director of Spiritual Care or Delegate at
Roswell Park. The interview date will be determined
by mutual agreement.

- An overview of your life, including a description of your immediate family, health status, educational experience, significant relationships, outstanding life events, and memorable periods of emotional and spiritual growth.
- A letter of recommendation from your pastor and/or spiritual leader.
- Personal goals and expectations for the program.
- A personal statement as to why you wish to enter the Spiritual Care Visitors 15-Week Training Program.
