In general, surgery and inpatient care including stem cell transplants take place at Oishei Children's Hospital; and outpatient chemotherapy and infusions, radiotherapy and radiosurgery take place at Roswell Park. We also collaborate with the Hemophilia Center of Western New York for patients with more severe bleeding and thrombotic conditions.

Pediatric, Adolescent and Young Adult Survivorship

Program to manage health conditions related to hormone, cardiac, low bone density and thyroid issues; address ongoing or late effects of treatment, such as anxiety or fertility concerns; provide social support, guidance and legal and financial assistance; and to aim for a higher level of lifelong wellness.
