## WHO GETS Ohä:tgi' Ye'dó'sageh (Breast Cancer)?

Breast cancer is the 2nd leading cause of cancer death for ALL women, and Native American women are more likely to be diagnosed at later stages compared to non-Hispanic white women.

Anyone can get breast cancer, and most women who develop breast cancer have no known risk factors. That's why ALL women, including Native American women, must be screened regularly for breast cancer.

The causes remain unclear, but some factors place you at high risk for the disease, such as:

- ✓ A family history of breast cancer among your parents, siblings or at least two other close relatives
- ✓ A personal or family history of ovarian cancer
- ✓ A relative diagnosed with breast cancer before menopause
- ✓ Multiple cancers within your family
- ✓ A known gene mutation, such as BRCA1, BRCA2, TP53, PTEN, PALB2, ATM or CHEK-2 in your family
- ✓ An abnormal breast biopsy
- ✓ Prior radiation to the chest as a child, teen or young adult
- ✓ Dense breast tissue
