

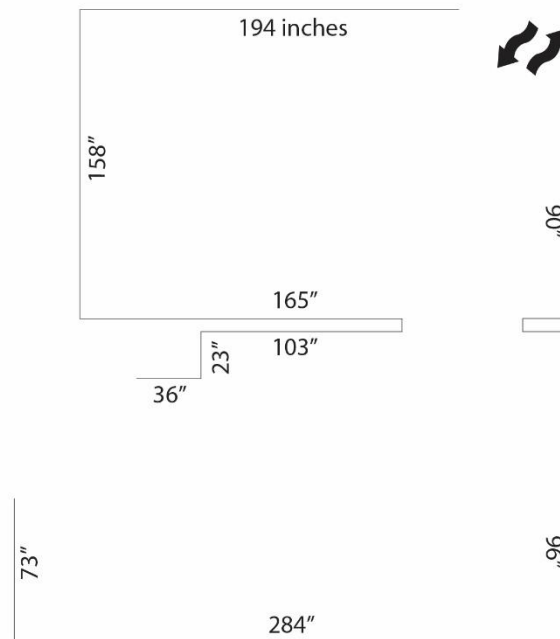
Call For Work: Roswell Park's Art Heals Gallery

The Roswell Park Alliance Foundation Art Committee is accepting exhibition proposals for future exhibition seasons in Roswell Park's Art Heals Gallery. Our on-campus art gallery is a drop-in space that provides a relaxing and peaceful oasis on campus for cancer patients, their caregivers, and Roswell Park staff. The gallery presents 4 exhibitions per year of work by contemporary artists with a connection to Western New York. Recent exhibitions include "Pause to Reflect: The Art of Life and Living" co-presented with the Western New York Urban Arts Collective; "Reflections: The Light Within" featuring work by Rita Argen Auerbach; as well as group exhibitions of work from the Roswell Park collection.

Exhibition proposals will be accepted from individual artists, collectives, or other artist groups. Proposals should be mindful of Roswell Park's captive audience and their unique circumstances and challenges. We aim to foster a gentle, relaxing, and therapeutic environment for all gallery visitors. All artists are encouraged to apply; however, the gallery steers away from presenting works that are overtly political, religious, visually arresting, or otherwise challenging to our patients.

Technical Information

The Art Heals Gallery has two presentation spaces, outlined below. The gallery is optimized to display traditional works such as paintings, drawings, photographs, and other pieces that can be hung on a wall. We are unable to display multimedia works, projected works, large sculptures or other oversized pieces, or installations. Works cannot be installed on the ceiling under any circumstances. In addition, all proposals must abide by Roswell Park's health and safety and infection control standards.
