☐ **I am a Special Disabled Veteran.** – (1) A veteran of the U.S. military ground, naval or air service who is entitled to compensation (or who but for the receipt of military retired pay would be entitled to compensation) under laws administered by the Department of Veteran's Affairs for a disability (a) rated at 30 percent or more or (b) rated at 10 or 20 percent in the case of a veteran who has been determined under Section 38 U.S.C. 3106 to have a serious employment handicap; OR (2) a person who was discharged or released from active duty because of a service-connected disability. ⁽⁶⁾

☐ **I am a Vietnam Era Veteran.** – A veteran who (1) served on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval or air service for a period of more than 180 days and was discharged or released therefrom with other than a dishonorable discharge if any part of such active duty occurred (a) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975 or (b) between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975 in all other cases; OR (2) was discharged or released from active duty for a service-connected disability if any part of such active duty was performed (a) in the Republic of Vietnam between February 28, 1961 and May 7, 1975 or (b) between August 5, 1964 and May 7, 1975 in all other cases. ⁽³⁾

☐ **I am a Recent Separated Veteran.** – A veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval or air service during the one-year period beginning on the date of such veteran's discharge or release from active duty. ⁽⁸⁾

☐ **I am an Other Protected Veteran.** – A veteran who served on active duty in the U.S. military ground, naval or air service during a war or in a campaign or expedition for which a campaign badge has been authorized under laws administered by the U.S. Department of Defense. ⁽⁷⁾
