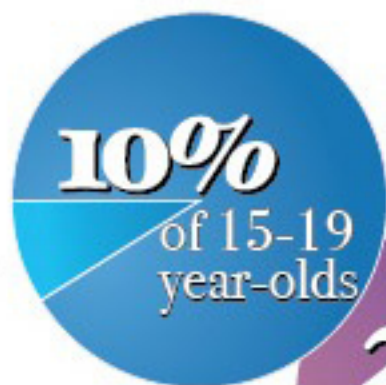

for AYAs have not
significantly changed in

30 years.

More than 60% of patients
under 15 years of age are
treated on a clinical trial
which has led to dramatic
improvements in childhood
cancer survival.



In contrast, only 10% of 15-19 year-olds
and 1-2% of 20-39 year-olds with a
cancer diagnosis participate
in a clinical trial.
