- 1. Fill out a Work Request Form in LIMS.
- 2. Obtain prefilled vials of 10% Neutral buffered formalin (10% NBF) from the Histology Facility (Basic Science Building room 601).
- 3. Please notify the Histology Facility 24 hours prior to the delivery of cells (845-3006).
- 4. A minimum of 5 x 10^6 cells are required for embedding (e.g. for TMA construction or multiple IHC markers). If only a small pellet is required for your project, fewer cells can be submitted.
- 5. If adherent cells should be trypsinized, keep treatment to a minimum and wash cells thoroughly in PBS.
- 6. The final suspension of the cell pellet should be in 1.5 mL of neutral buffered formalin in a 1.5 mL of neutral buffered formalin in a 1.5 mL
- 7. Deliver cells, at room temperature, immediately to the Histology Facility, room 601.
- 8. Cells should arrive in the Histology Facility by 1pm.
