Founded by Dr. Elias Cohen in 1964, The Donor Center at Roswell Park is among the three oldest platelet collection facilities in the country. In addition to its long-standing history, The Donor Center is one of the few centers in the country that employs an all nursing staff. Several of our Donor Center nurses have been in blood and platelet collections for over 25 years affording donors a high level of expertise, rigorous standards of care as well as compassion and dignity with each donation. Donors are immediately put at ease when they are cared for and monitored by our professional nurses at Roswell Park Cancer Institute.

Your Help is Needed

Both their disease and treatment can result in blood loss and anemia as well as low platelet counts for cancer patients. A transfusion of red cells or platelets may become necessary to address effects from:

- A compromised ability to produce enough platelets on their own (often as a result of the type of cancer of type of treatment)
- Blood loss during surgery
- Anemia
- Chemotherapy drugs and/or radiation treatments

SAVING LIVES IS EASY AND REWARDING

Please consider making any of the following donations to RPCI:

PLATELET

A platelet donation takes about 1.5 to 2 hours, and you may donate every 2 weeks.

WHOLE BLOOD

A whole blood donation takes about 45 minutes, and you may donate whole blood every 56 days.

PLATELETS/RED CELLS

Donating two critical blood components simultaneously can benefit multiple patients. This donation type takes approximately 2 hours and you may donate every 56 days. You

Donor Criteria

Apheresis

the process that separates out

the blood.

You must be in good general health and:

- At least 17 years old
- Weigh a minimum of 110 pounds
- Not have donated blood in the past 56 days
- Not had a tattoo in the past 12 months
- Have eaten a meal 1 to 2 hours before donation
