PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

This conference will provide the participant with a reflective process that integrates the wisdom of such writers as Parker J. Palmer, John O'Donohue, Joan Chittister, OSB, Rachel Naomi Remen and Carrie Newcomer into a tapestry of current theory and authentic practice which renews & sustains authentic spiritual care ministers.

Through lecture, conversation, story, song, poetry and silence, participants will be invited to explore their own thresholds in their life and ministry— those times of transition and/or transformation where one finds oneself poised between the known and the unknown, between what has been and what is yet to be.

OBJECTIVES

1. Participants will articulate and explore the notion of 'threshold' as it relates to their personal calling and identify its significance in their life and ministry.
2. Participants will learn from the insights of writers, artists and poets, (as well as each other), methods of "befriending the unknown".
3. Participants will describe and assess the relationship between personal transformation (soul) and authentic ministry (role).
4. Participants will examine the relationship and significance of solitude within the context of effective collaborative ministry.
