INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING RPCI VOLUNTEER MEDICAL CERTIFICATION

Item #1 - Please enter your name, date of birth

Item #2 - Please enter you Telephone #'s and SS#

Item #3 – Please enter your emergency contact information

Item #4 – Have you ever had chicken pox? Answer either yes or no if the answer is no then you must provide the two dates that you have had the Chicken pox vacations.

Item #5 Have you ever had measles? Answer either yes or no if the answer is no then you must provide the two dates that you have had the Measles vacations.

Item #6 – Did you have mumps Answer either yes or no if the answer is no then you must provide the two dates that you have had the Measles vacations.

Item #7 – Have you ever had a positive PPD test? If not, you will need 2 tests before you can volunteer.

*Please note - A PPD test checks to see if you are a carrier of tuberculosis. A person can be a carrier of tuberculoses but never show any signs or symptoms in their whole life. If you are a carrier it is possible to give it to someone who has their immune system severely compromised. You can have your PPD tests implanted at the Roswell Employee Health clinic free of charge or by your personal physician. You must wait atleast one week between tests.

The test is done by putting a small amount of TB protein under the top layer of skin on your inner forearm. If you have ever been exposed to the TB bacteria, your skin will react to the antigens by developing a firm red bump at the site within 2 days. Your TB test must be read 48-72 hours from Implant.

If you have had a positive PPD read, you must have a Xray that shows you are negative for TB within the past two calander years.
