## I. Chairman's Opening Remarks

Mr. Manning welcomed all and thanked everyone for attending this Special It Oversight Committee meeting to discuss the Data Science Architecture. Mr. Manning also welcomed Genevieve Schimpfle for joining the committee.

Dr. Odunsi explained the rationale for the contractual relationship with White River Computing to provide RPCI with a cutting-edge technical research infrastructure that will enhance research capabilities through new and expanded capacity to access, integrate and organize the data generated by RPCI investigators.

Dr. Odunsi and management recommends that the this committee approve this request for a total spend of \$3,428,750; \$3,230,000 in capital funds to develop a Data Science Architecture using White River Computing as the primary developer, as well as \$198,750 over 5 years to host the platform in the cloud.

Upon motion by Ms. NeMoyer and seconded by Ms. Lorenz, the request of \$3,428,750 was unanimously approved.
