What Sets Us Apart

- Chimeric Antigen Receptor (CAR) T-cell therapies. We are the only pediatric program in upstate New York to offer these promising new FDA-approved immunotherapy treatments for relapsed leukemia and lymphoma.
- Expanded Blood & Marrow Transplant program now provides stem cell and marrow transplants to children of all ages for treatment of cancer, sickle cell anemia, immune disorders and other nonmalignant disorders.
- **Experimental Therapeutics** program offers NCI-sponsored, Children's Oncology Group, pharmaceutical and investigator initiated clinical trials of novel agents specifically for children with cancer and blood disorders.
- Comprehensive molecular testing with OmniSeq Comprehensive[™] and Immune Report Card[™] to match personalized therapy to patients.
- **Outpatient erythrocytapheresis** and other chronic transfusion therapies for sickle cell diseases, thalassemias, and other severe anemias.

Streamlined Coordination of Care

While the joint pediatric program has provided high-quality hematology and oncology care for decades, with the newly built John R. Oishei Children's Hospital (OCH) joining Roswell Park Comprehensive Cancer Center on the Buffalo Niagara Medical Campus, we saw an opportunity for a consolidated and more efficient Pediatric Cancer and Blood Disorders program built on the unique services and expertise of each institution.

THE NEW PROGRAM WILL RESULT IN:

- Increased collaboration on best practices and quality assurance across the continuum of inpatient and outpatient pediatric cancer care.
- Development of new specialized programs for pediatric cancers and blood disorders.

Our Approach to Care

Our patients will have streamlined access to the clinical and support services of both centers. In general, surgery and inpatient care including blood and marrow transplants will take place at Oishei Children's Hospital; and outpatient chemotherapy and infusions, radiotherapy and radiosurgery will take place at Roswell Park. We also collaborate with the Hemophilia Center of Western New York for patients with more severe bleeding and thrombotic conditions.

AT JOHN R. OISHEI CHILDREN'S HOSPITAL Ralph C. Wilson, Jr Pediatric Hematology/Oncology Suite

- Inpatient oncology and hematology unit offers full environmental protection for our patients, providing these severely immune-compromised children with the safest infrastructure for care.
- Children have full access to their unit's hallways and playroom, an important component of maintaining their psychosocial and physical health, rather than confined to their own room.
- Pediatric surgical units are uniquely designed for the youngest patients.
- Advanced imaging and testing with support by pediatric staff.
- Full array of pediatric subspecialty services including critical care expertise are available on site.

AT ROSWELL PARK COMPREHENSIVE CANCER CENTER Katherine, Anne & Donna Gioia Pediatric Hematology Oncology Center

- New outpatient center brings all ambulatory services for childhood cancer and blood disorders to one location, centralizing care that previously was delivered in two outpatient centers.
- Gamma Knife radiosurgery and conventional radiation therapy. Roswell Park is the only regional provider performing cranial radiosurgery with Gamma Knife.
- Blood & Marrow Transplant program recognized as Blue Distinction Center by BlueCross BlueShield Association.
- Specialized multidisciplinary pediatric programs for Sickle Cell and Thalassemia, Thrombosis Clinic, and Pediatric Cancer Susceptibility Screening.
- Covered access to the center from the parking ramp via an all-weather bridge connector.
- Access to innovative therapies through our expanding portfolio of clinical trials specifically for pediatric patients.



Support Services

Pediatric, Adolescent and Young Adult Survivorship Program to manage health conditions related to hormone, cardiac, low bone density and thyroid issues; address ongoing or late effects of treatment, such as anxiety or fertility concerns; provide social support, guidance and legal and financial assistance; and to aim for a higher level of lifelong wellness.

Integrative Medicine program for young patients and their families to ease the impact of cancer treatment. Modalities include acupuncture, acupressure, massage therapy, reflexology, aromatherapy and mind-body therapy.

Pediatric Psychology, Social Work and Child Life Specialists dedicated to the outpatient and inpatient pediatric cancer and blood disorders centers.

Patient Navigator for our Sickle Cell and Thalassemia Program.

Courage of Carly Fund (Roswell Park) and Stone's Buddies (OCH) provide support, events and outings for families with a child facing cancer or other chronic, life-threatening illness.
